RESIDENTIAL STACKER DOOR

Lidco is pleased to have developed a new high performance Residential Stacker Door. The 133 system combines aesthetic design, superior performance and ease of operation, and has been developed to ensure ease of fabrication for the manufacturers.

The unique design includes:

- Ability to screen via an external integrated sliding screen track
- Clean jamb
- Ability to accommodate up to 3 sliding sashes
- Ability to double glaze
- Utilises existing sashes from Lidco Lifestyle doors
- Frame size 125mm
- Hand machinable

The 133 stacker door can utilise the standard 718 series sub-sills and heads for high performance requirements. Consistent with the high quality delivered in Lidco products throughout the range, the 133 system gives architects the opportunity to specify a door that combines creativity, functionality and peace of mind.

The door is currently undergoing testing and is due to be released later in the year.

MODIFIED SLIDING DOOR HEAD TO ACCOMMODATE FLYSCREEN


In response to requests from our customer base, Lidco have designed a new head for our 132 residential sliding door system.

The existing head has been modified to now include a roller track, thereby allowing a sliding screen sash to run smoothly on rollers both top and bottom. This improves the operation of the sash and resultant longevity of the hardware.

100mm SLIDING WINDOW 740 SYSTEM

While this system could previously be screened, it required a cumbersome looking angle trim to be fitted around the entire perimeter. We have now cut a new section which allows for screening the opening sash only. The flyscreen sits on the new section fitted to the existing track, and is housed within the standard window head.

In addition, we have also developed a snap in jamb receiver to permit the same frame section to be used full height when the window requires a highlight or lowlight. Previously, the fabricator was forced to use either a pocket filler and plant on jamb receiver, or change framing sections when the highlight/lowlight meets the operable window. This results in reduced labour involvement and a more professional looking product.



Lidco's extensive range of framing solutions continues to undergo product enhancements to meet changing market and design requirements.

SNAP ON FACE FIX ADAPTORS FOR FACE FIXING WINDOWS

Lidco's 110 and 112 sliding window systems and 140 awning window system, now have the added flexibility to convert to a face fix window with the use of snap on flanges.

This section snaps neatly and easily into the head, jamb and sill, creating a window which can be face fixed if required.

This delivers a solution for fitting windows between posts when closing in a verandah, sandwich panels, on site sheds or single skin walls. Previously doing so was either unachievable or time consuming.


LSS-148 FACE FIX ADAPTOR

NEW GLAZING ADAPTOR FOR SLIMLINE MIDRAILS

Developed to suit our 150 hinged door system, 800 Heritage hinged door system, and 615 Visionair bifold door system, the new glazing bead allows for a more slimline midrail than previously achievable.

Developed to meet the increasing trend being driven by designers and architects for more slimline and versatile midrails, this design is 100mm overall and can be easily tailored to suit a wide range of designs.

The size and nature of the midrail permits multiple horizontal or raked midrails to be incorporated in each door, and can be single or double glazed.




NEW 250MM FACE GLAZED SHOPFRONT RANGE

The construction industry continues to push the boundaries of design, requiring larger window/door panels in high wind areas. At Lidco we pride ourselves on being able to deliver a solution for any glazing requirement and thus have developed a 250mm face glazed shopfront system.

This permits both larger panels and the ability to stand up to extreme weather circumstances where maximum strength is required.

Where the previous offering of the 150mm system sometimes required reinforcement within the vertical sections and/or a reduction in the size of the panels, the 250mm system will support designers with their intent.
